## Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

We will focus on:  
Initiating conversations and forming good relationships with the people around us.

Building confidence to talk to others in small groups.



## Communication and Language

We will learn to:

- Listen to others in small groups
- Listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.
- Join in with repeated refrains.
- Understand and respond to instructions and questions.
- Use more complex sentences when communicating.
- Use of range of vocabulary to convey meaning.



## Physical Development (PD)

We will focus on:

- Experimenting with different ways of moving
- Travelling around, under, through balancing and climbing equipment
- Parachute games
- Handwriting practice for writing our names.
- Holding a pencil and using scissors correctly.
- Becoming increasingly independent with our self-help skills.



## Literacy

We will use the following core texts to support our literacy work:

- *A range of non-fiction books for people who help us,*
- *Jasper's beanstalk, Fran's flower, Dora's chicks.*
- *Harry and the bucketful of dinosaurs, non-fiction dinosaur books.*

We will focus on:

- Giving meaning to all of our marks
- Writing our name
- Listening for the initial sounds in words.
- Blending and segmenting words.
- Describing main story settings, characters and events.



## Maths

We will learn to:

- Chant aloud beyond 10.
- Separate objects in different ways.
- Recognise numbers 0-10.
- Match numeral and quantity.
- Count aloud saying one number name for each object.
- Count aloud saying one number name for each movement e.g. counting claps.
- Talk about the shapes of everyday objects.
- Name and recognise 2d shapes.
