**HOST NATION:  
GREECE**

**ENTRY POINT:** learning about the story treasure island

**MATHS:** In Maths we will be looking at numbers up to 100 and place value as well as addition and subtraction. The children will learn to count in steps of 2,3,4, 5 and 10 from any number forward and backward. Recognise the place value digit in a two-digit number. Use place value and number facts to solve problems. Solve problems with addition and subtraction. Apply knowledge of mental and written methods.



**ENGLISH:** In English we will be learning to write stories with a familiar setting. We are also learning to write explanation texts. Near the end of the term we learn about poetry and non-chronological texts



**HISTORY:** We will find out about significant figures. We will focus on Ma Farah and his early life.



**GEOGRAPHY:** We will learn about the countries and cultures linked to the pirates we travelled on a map

**ART/DT:** We will design and make our own treasure map and coin.



**PSHE:** We will learn about ourselves and others. We discuss what makes the children individual and how they are different from others
