Dear Parents and Carers

We do hope your child has enjoyed completing the Activity Guide and you and your child have had the opportunity to view the Virtual Tour and meet key members of staff. Remember to visit <https://eastburycomp.fluencycms.co.uk/Transition-Y6-into-Y7-2020> to gain access to the virtual tour and other resources that have been shared to support you and your family at this exciting transition time.

At Eastbury Community School we understand and value the impact of positive communication. Starting on Thursday 25th June, a member of staff from ECS (Eastbury Community School) will be making a phone call home to you and your child. During this conversation you will have an opportunity to ask questions and also receive important information. The member of staff will ask your child about the Activity Guide and the tasks they have completed so far. Information about the Transition Week, beginning Monday 29th June will also be discussed.

What is the Transition Week?

Beginning on Monday 29th June, we invite your child to participate in the ECS Virtual Transition Week. The week will be fun filled with activities, lessons and competitions for your child to engage with. The activities will be presented in a variety of forms, with video demonstrations, power point presentations and activity tasks.

Each morning at 9am, a folder will be uploaded to the transition page on the ECS website. Use the link <https://eastburycomp.fluencycms.co.uk/Transition-Y6-into-Y7-2020> to access the folder. In the folder you will find a series of lessons and activities to be enjoyed and completed for that day. I have included a timetable for the transition week in this correspondence to help you prepare for the week ahead. Your child's primary school has been informed about the plans for the transition week and they will also have access to the transition page on our website.

Included with this letter is a resource document 'Coat of Arms'. This activity is a pastoral competition, set by the transition and tutor team. The Coat of Arms competition is on the timetable for Monday 29th as part of the transition week. To support this competition there will be a power point available on Monday 29th June, and Mr Oberholzer, your child's Head of Year, has made a video with the tutor team to inspire and motivate participation. We encourage your child to design their own 'Coat of Arms' and share a motto as part of their Coat of Arms design. Your child should keep their Coat of Arms safe during the summer holiday and designs will be submitted in September. We have included a piece of cartridge paper for your child to complete their design.

In this correspondence you will also find an 'All about me' booklet. This booklet was created by Ms Higson who is Head of Curriculum Access, and it has been shared to support all pupils. Please do encourage your child to complete this booklet at their leisure. Again, it would be great if this booklet could be kept safe during the summer and available to share in September (although this is not a mandatory request).
