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


Reading with your child in Year 2




Some questions to ask your child whilst reading together:

- 1. Look at the front cover. What could the book be about?
- 2. Who is the author?
- 3. What is an illustrator? What do they do?
- 4. What does that word mean? Read the words around it to help you figure it out.
- 5. How can you read an unfamiliar word? Can you sound talk and then blend?
- 6. Who are the main characters?
- 7. What do you think will happen next?
- 8. How do you think the character feels? Why? How would you feel in that situation?
- 9. Can you predict how the book will end?
- 10. Who is your favourite character? Why?
- 11. Can you retell the story in your own words?
- 12. Do you like how the story ended? Can you think of another way the book could have ended?
