- 8. How do you think the character feels? Why? How would you feel in that situation?
- 9. Can you predict how the book will end?
- 10. Who is your favourite character? Why?
- 11. Can you retell the story in your own words?
- 12. Do you like how the story ended? Can you think of another way the book could have ended?
