



Year 1 Maths Targets

Target
I can count forwards and backwards from any number up to 100.
I can count, read and write numbers to 100 and I can count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
I can say one more and one less than any number below 100.
I can make, draw or show you a number up to 100, including on a number line and I can use words like equal to, more than, less than, fewer, most and least to talk about numbers.
I can read and write numbers to 20 in words: one, two three...
I can use +, - and = and understand what they mean.
I can use number bonds to 20 to add and subtract.
I can add and subtract a TU and U number to 20.
I can use counters, pictures and number lines to solve adding and subtracting problems and I can solve missing number problems like: $7 = n - 9$.
I can recognise half of an object, a shape or a number.
I can recognise quarter of an object, a shape or a number.
I can use counters and some help to solve grouping and sharing problems.
I can say the 10s timetable and use it to work out division facts. I can count on and back in 10s from any number.
I can use doubling and halving facts to 10 and other important doubles like double 50 is 100.
I know the odd and even numbers up to 20.
I can solve problems about length and height using words like long, longer, longest, short, shorter and shortest.
I can solve problems about weight and mass using words like heavy, heavier, heaviest, light, lighter and lightest
I can solve problems about capacity and volume using words like full, half full, quarter full or three-quarters full.
I can solve problems about time using words like fast, faster, fastest, slow, slower and slowest.
I can measure length and height in centimetres (cm) and metres (m) and record these measurements.
I can measure mass and weight in grams (g) and kilograms (kg) and record these measurements.
I can measure capacity and volume in millilitres (ml) and litres (l) and record these measurements.
I can measure time in seconds, minutes and hours and record these measurements.
I can find coins and notes that are worth 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1, £2, £5, £10 and £20.
I can put events in time order using words like first, last, before and after.
I know the days of the week and months of the year and can use these to say today's date.
I can tells the time using words like o'clock and half past.
I can find and name 2-D shapes like rectangles, squares, circles and triangles.
I can find and name 3-D shapes like cuboids, cubes, pyramids and spheres.
I can describe position and movement using words like whole turn, half turn, quarter turn and three-quarter turns. I can use these words to give directions.
I can group objects into sets using their properties.
I can answer questions by counting the number of objects in a set.
I can sort shapes using their properties.
