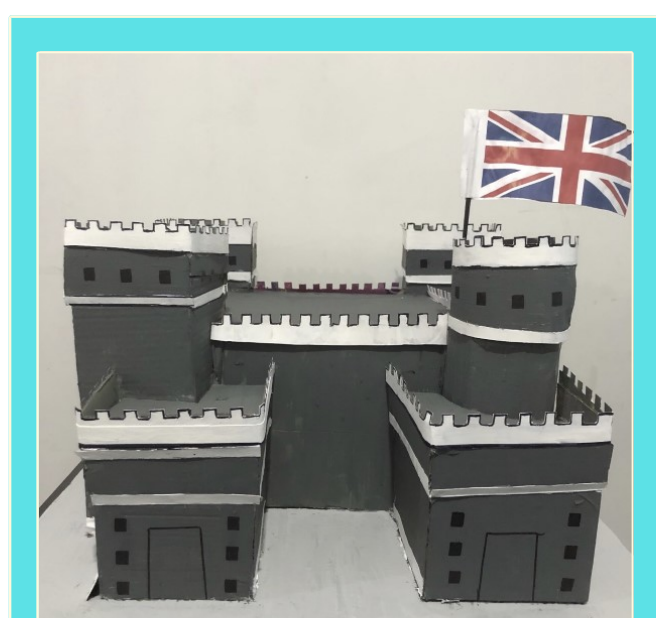

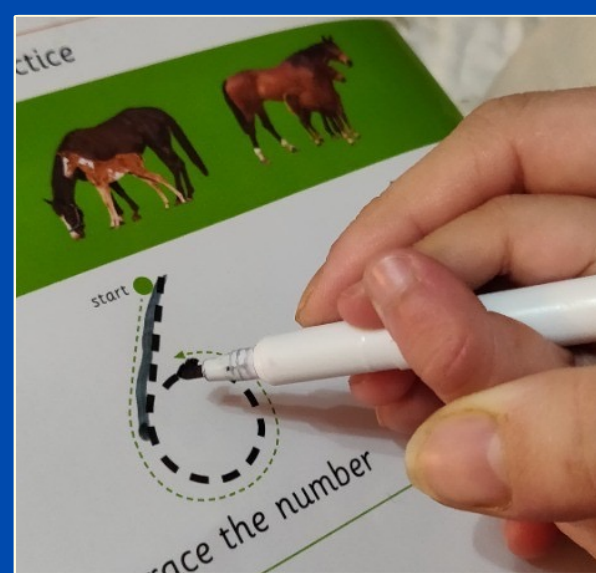
Areeba (1D) made a fantastic model of her favourite toy. Well Done!



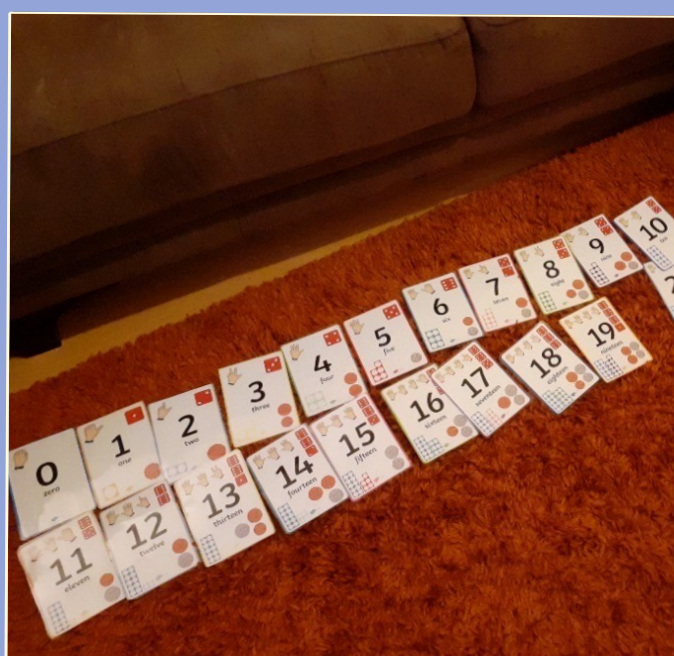
Hansel and Gretel 06/01/2021

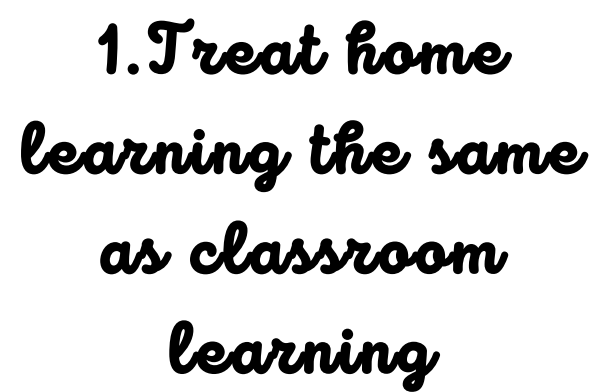
