Pupils have been learning about sustainability: reducing, reusing and recycling. Our very talented Miss Fab created this fantastic display to help teach and inspire the rest of the school.

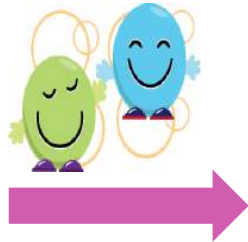
I liked that we got to try out different techniques in shading using special sketching pencils. We were given the challenge to shade in our Shang drawings in only one colour.
