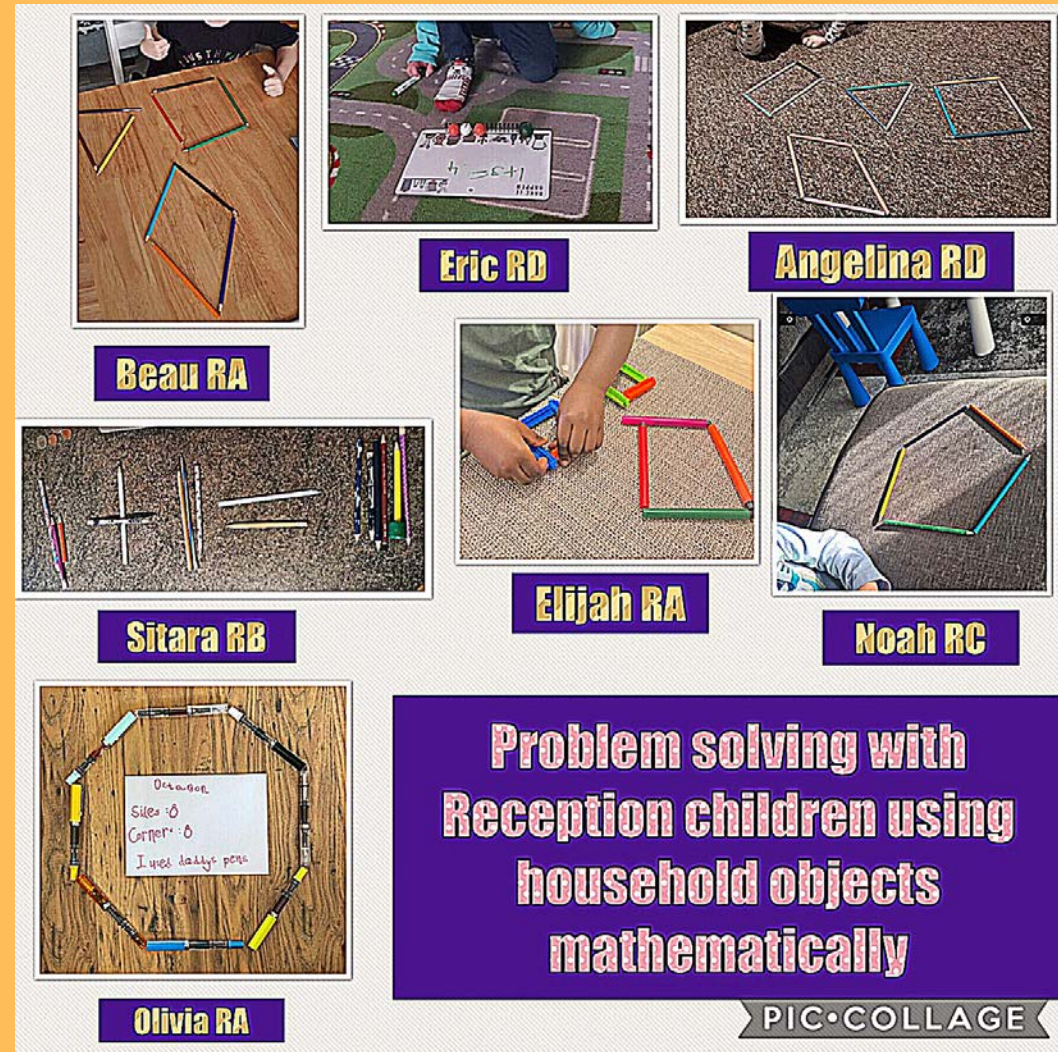

Iris (Nursery) has been painting and exploring colours!



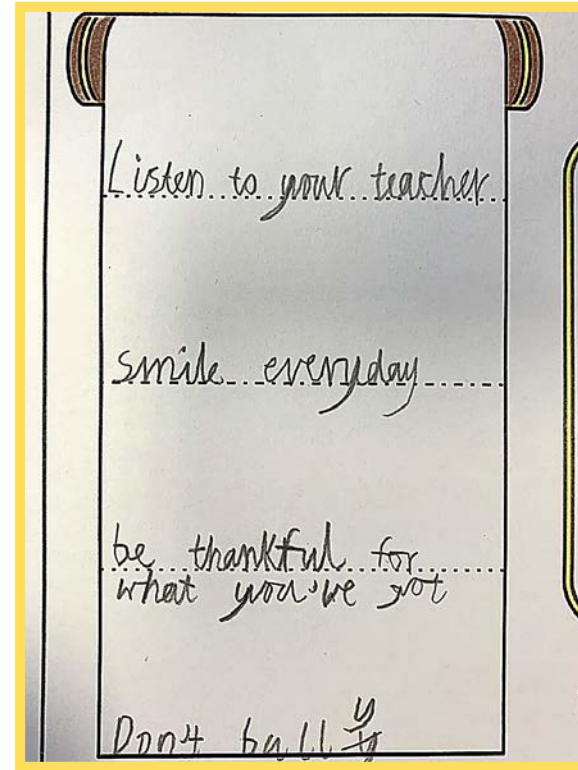
In ART, Aadya (1C) has created a monster using tissue roll, straws and paint.



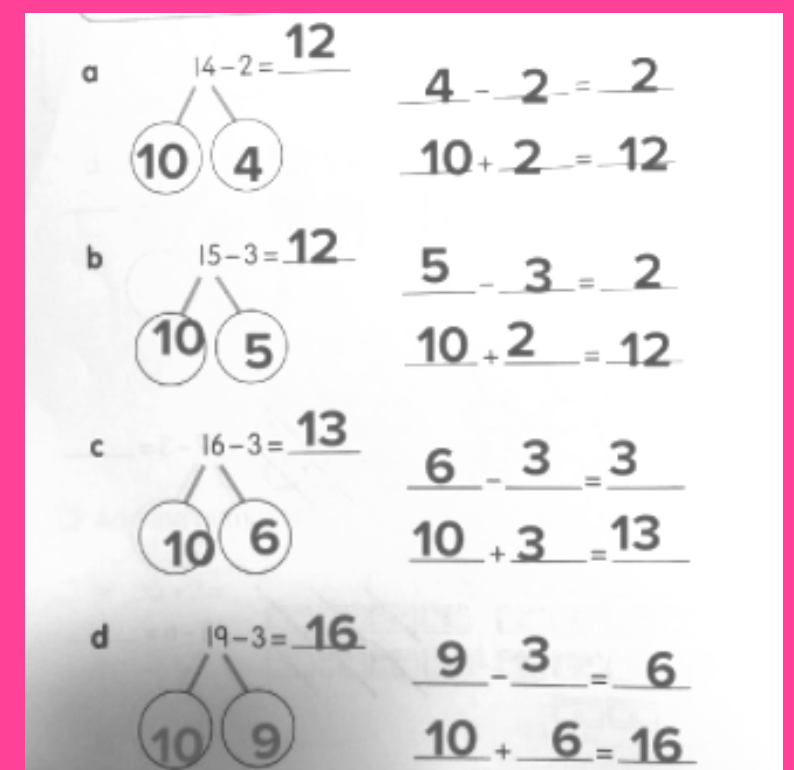
Amanah's lovely (1B) RE work! All about welcoming special people.

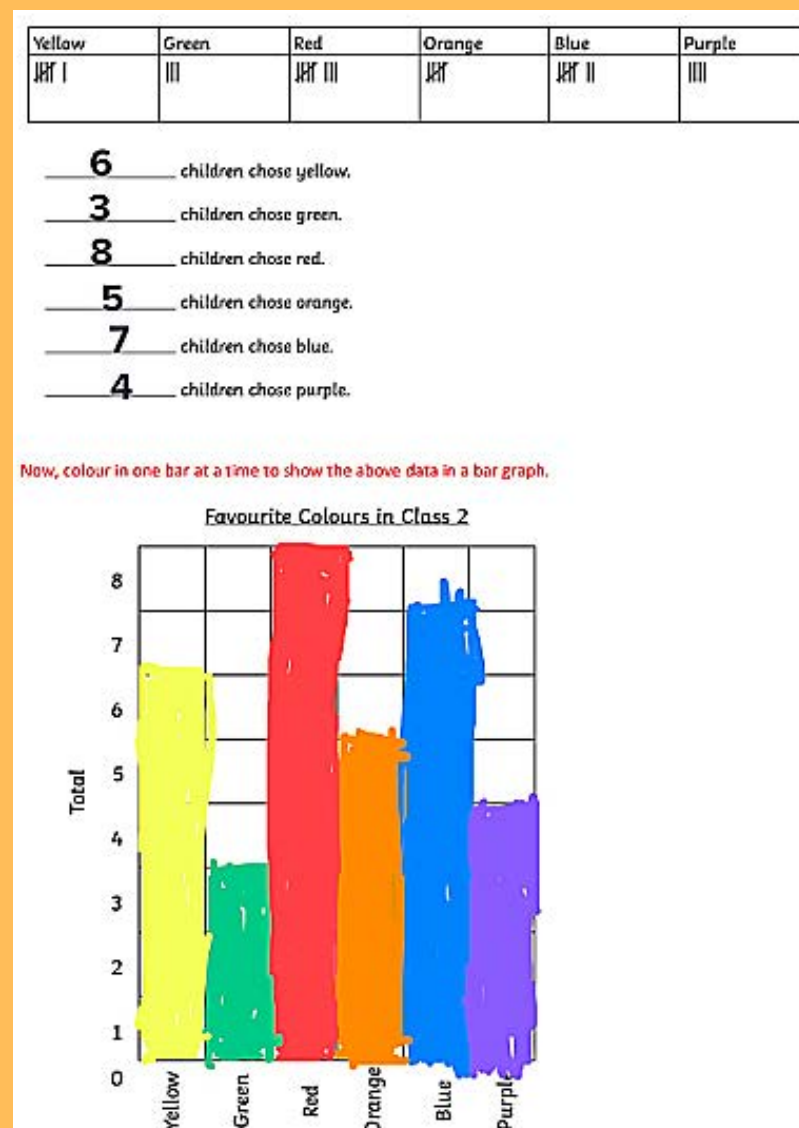

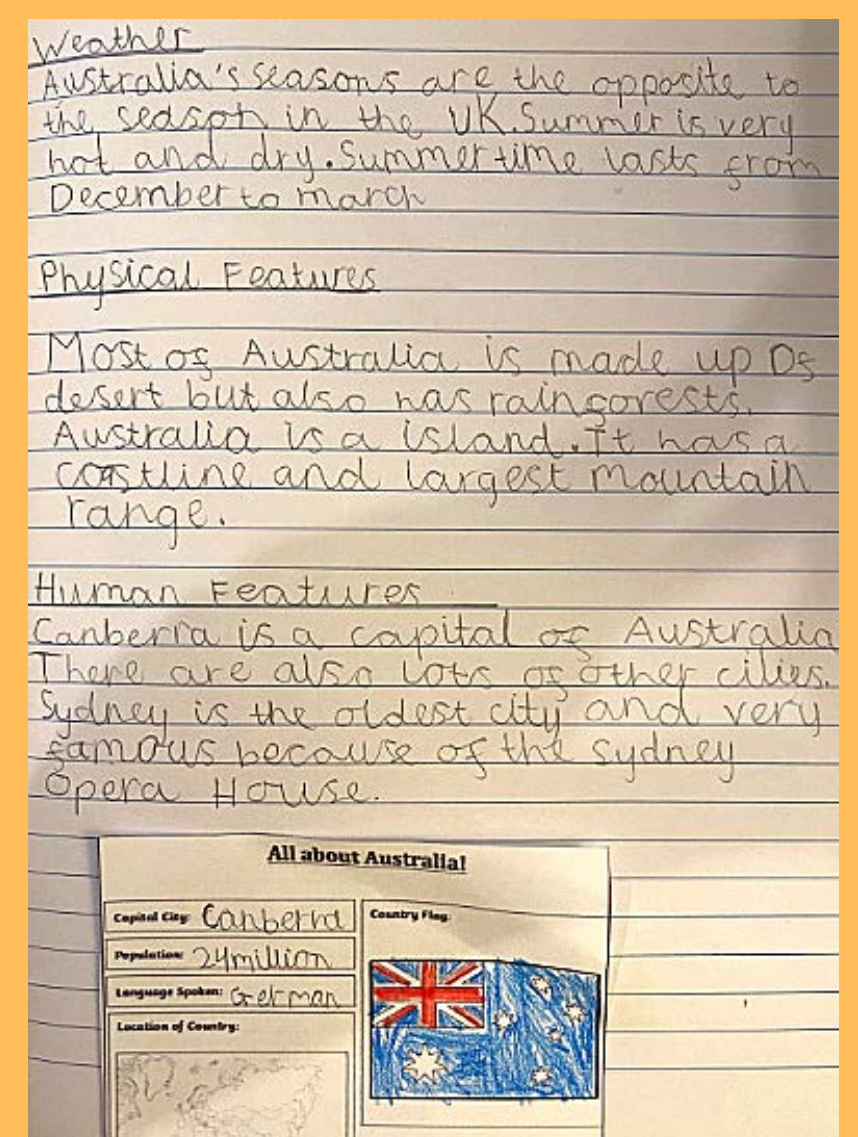
Year 1 have created monsters in ART using mixed media! Very creative!

Zayn (2B) A colourful bar graph created using information in a tally chart.



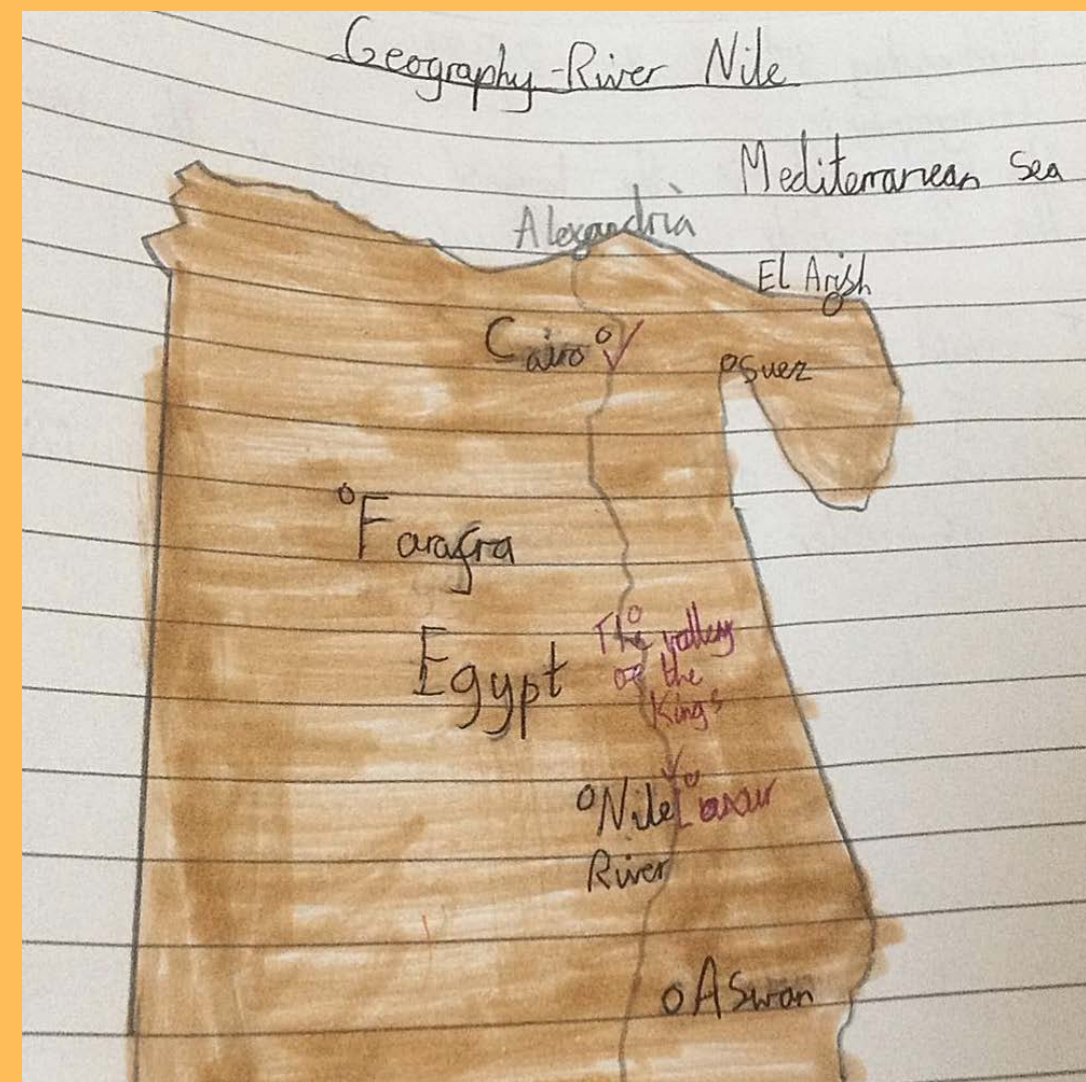
