Thank you for booking a place for your child to attend Barking Abbey's Year 6 to 7 summer school.

The summer school will be running from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> – Friday 27<sup>th</sup> August at Barking Abbey School. The week will provide your child with the opportunity to meet their new teachers and classmates and get to know them better, ready for the start of school in September.

The summer school will run across both campuses and your child should therefore only attend the campus they have been allocated in September.

**Each day will begin promptly at 9am with lunch at 12pm and the school day will finish at 2pm.  
Students arrive in the morning outside our Woodbridge road entrance/gate.**

Throughout the week, students will be provided with lunch, however you may wish them to bring their own packed lunch if they would like.

Students can wear any appropriate clothing, though active wear is recommended, as they will be taking part in numerous sporting and active sessions.

On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> August, all students will be based at the Sandringham Road campus for a year group sports day. The timings for the day will remain the same however drop offs and collections will be at the Woodbridge Road entrance.

On this day we ask Longbridge Road students to wear a black top, black bottoms and trainers and Sandringham Road students to wear a red top, black bottoms and trainers. Preferably the tops should be plain however some detail, print or embroidery is allowed. As we will be outside all day can you please ensure your child packs for all kinds of weather including a coat, sun cream, hayfever tablets if needed and remember to bring plenty of water.
