LEARNING OUTSIDE!


Our aim is to teach children that learning can occur everywhere! Have a look at the high-quality learning taking place outside the four walls this term.

Year 2 became explorers. They travelled the world using different modes of transport and in different weathers. They sheltered in tents and discovered that their food was running out!


YEAR 3 HUNTERS & GATHERERS

Year 4 have also been looking for similarities and differences between deciduous trees.










Year 6 have been analysing paintings by artists during the wars. They enjoyed working in the Garden centre.
