

## Understanding of the World (UW)

In understanding of the world we will be talking about our family, making friends and learning how we are similar and different to others.

Your children will have access to a range of small world toys so that they can recreate different scenarios, such as farms and train sets.

We will also be acquiring basic ICT skills using a range of equipment, such as computers, tablets and programmable toys.

## Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

This term, we will be singing nursery rhymes and exploring different musical instruments. We will also be using a range of materials and mark making equipment to explore colour and shape.

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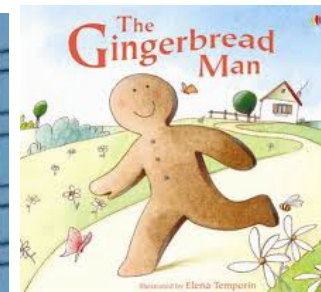

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

We will focus on:

- Separating from our parents and carers and exploring the Nursery.
- Making new friends and learning about behaviour expectations in the setting.

## Communication and Language

We will be:

- Listening to stories and each other
- Starting to understand more complex sentences.
- Learning new words
- Learning to use simple sentences to communicate.

## Physical Development (PD)

We will focus on:

- exploring the garden and using our bodies to move in a variety of ways.
- practising our control in holding and using different objects in the environment.
- becoming more independent in self help skills.

## Literacy

We will use the following core texts to support our literacy work:

- *A range of fairy tale and nursery rhyme tales*
- *The Gingerbread man and Little Red Riding Hood*

We will focus on:

Reading: This term we will be looking at books about starting nursery, being kind to others and ourselves. We will begin to repeat phrases from our favourite stories.

Writing: The children will be encouraged to make marks and give them meaning.

We will begin to identify different sounds that we hear around us, such as garden noises, musical instruments and different voices.

## Maths

Numbers: This term we will be singing counting songs, using numbers in our play and experimenting with different quantities of objects.

Shape, Space and Measure: The children will be sorting objects by shape, size and colour and exploring shapes in their environment.
