### How do families differ?



## Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

We will learn to settle into our classrooms, make new friends and adjust to our new timetable.

We will learn the expected behaviour for school.

We will learn how to take turns, how to share and how to work in pairs and in small groups.

We will learn how to make choices and talk about our feelings and emotions.

## Communication and Language (C & L)

We will learn to listen carefully, take turns when talking and respond in a range of situations.

We will learn to speak in loud, clear and confident voices.

We will learn to speak using full sentences.

We will extend our vocabulary in association with our topics.

We will learn to use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences.

We will use talk to sequence and clarify our thoughts, ideas, feelings and events.

## Physical Development (PD)

We will learn how to take our coats and jumpers on and off and we will learn about basic hygiene.

We will have daily access to the outdoor area and will learn about dressing appropriately for this.

We will learn how to move with awareness of others and how to use the space around us.

We will learn how to climb and balance safely and how to travel around, under, over and through various equipment.

We will develop our fine motor skills using a range of small tools (scissors, paintbrushes, cutlery) through a variety of daily activities.

We will learn to use anticlockwise movements, re-trace lines and form recognisable letters.

## Literacy

We will be using the following core texts to support our literacy work:

-Owl babies

-Cotton wool Colin

-Can't sleep Little Bear

-The Bear and the Piano

We will learn to recognise and write our name from memory. We will also learn to write labels, captions and cards.

We will learn to identify and pronounce the pure sounds that letters make.

We will learn to write letters using the correct formation.

We will learn to listen for sounds in words.

We will learn how to blend and segment sounds to support reading and writing.

We will learn to form lower case and capital letters correctly.

-Use and understand new recently introduced vocabulary.

## Maths

We will learn to count forwards and backwards to 10 and beyond.

We will learn to count objects, actions and sounds up to 10 and beyond.

We will learn to recognise written numbers from 1 to 10.

We will learn to subitise (recognise quantities without counting) up to 5.

We will learn to identify one more and one less than a given number.

We will learn to compare quantities up to 10 recognising when one quantity is greater than/less than/the same as the other quantity.
