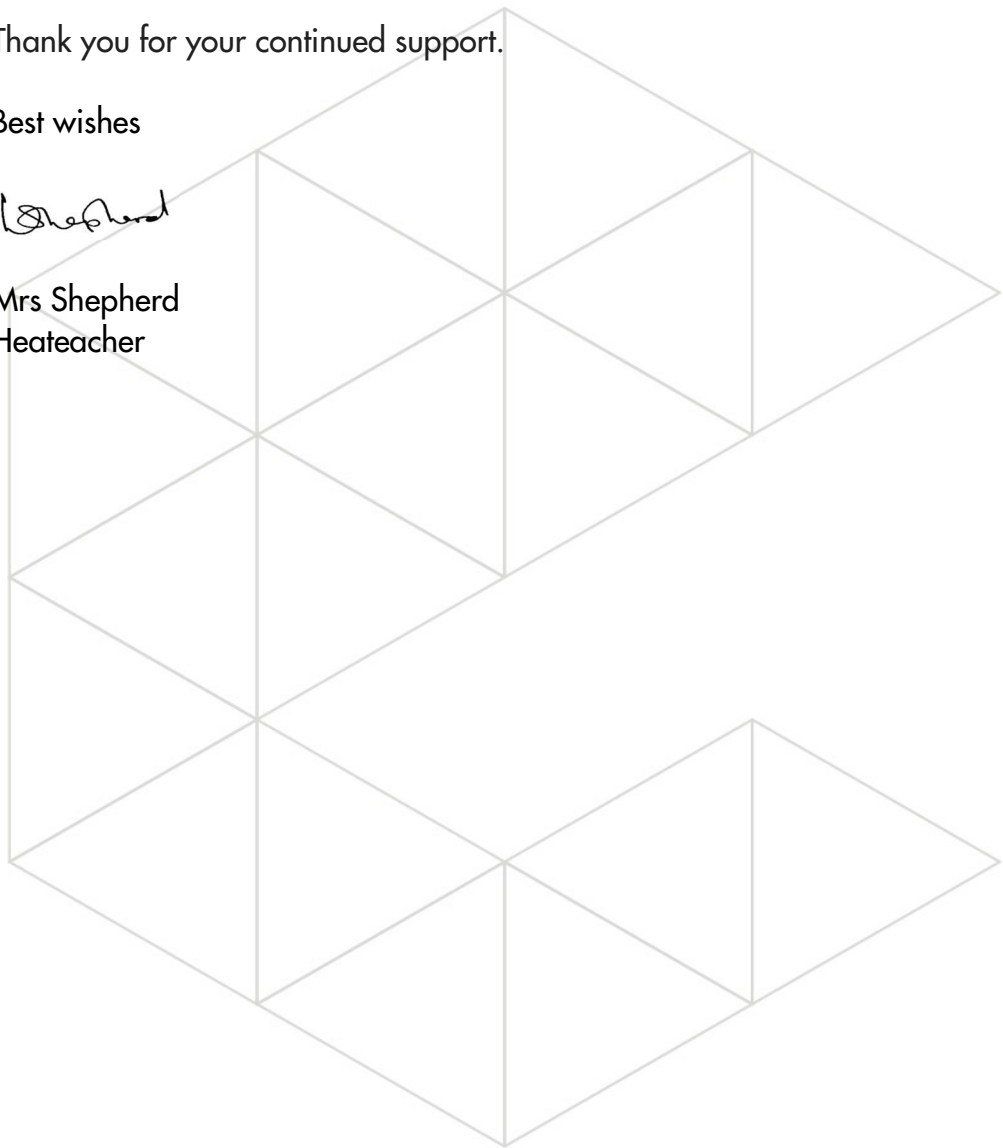
We are working closely with our teaching staff so that we can advise you of the plans for further strike action, and I will inform you of the arrangements as soon as possible.
