Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been very positive to see so many of you at the meet the teacher meetings, which have taken place over the last few weeks. If you were unable to attend these, all the information is on Class Dojo and the school website. If you don't have a log in, please speak to your child's teacher, who can arrange this for you.

Attendance

Please ensure that your child comes to school on time every day, so that they do not miss any of their learning. The government's expectation is that children's attendance should be 97% or above. It is therefore important that any medical appointments with the doctor or dentist are made outside of school hours.

School Uniform and PE Kit

Children are expected to wear the schools full uniform, including black shoes and have a PE Kit in school. It will help your child if all items were clearly labelled so that any items can be returned to them if they are lost. PE Kits enable the children to change back into their smart school clothes after their lessons.

Children should only wear stud earrings to school to avoid any injuries during their PE lessons, sports clubs and lunchtimes. Necklaces should also not be worn.

School Trips - Packed Lunch

Your child's teacher will be organising a number of exciting school trips during the year. As all primary school children are now entitled to a free school lunch, they are also entitled to a **free school packed lunch** when they go on a school trip. Due to food allergies, **this must be ordered by the parent** when they agree to their child going on the trip. **Unfortunately, unless an order is received by the given deadline, a packed lunch cannot be provided by the school.**
